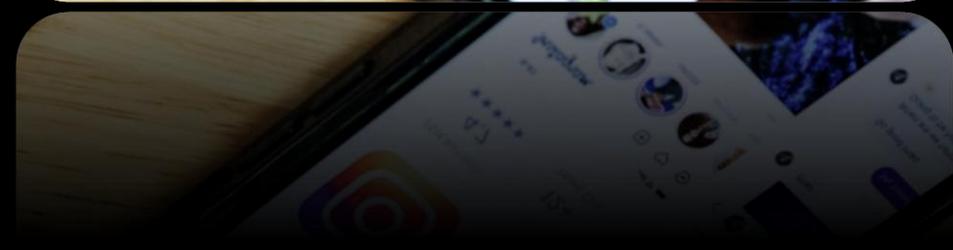

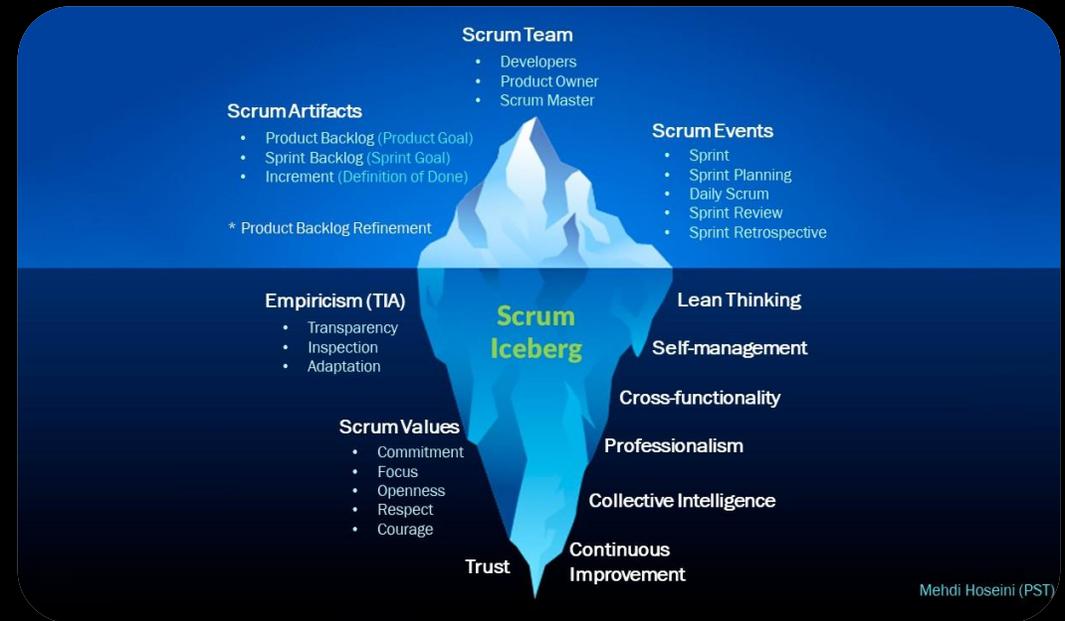

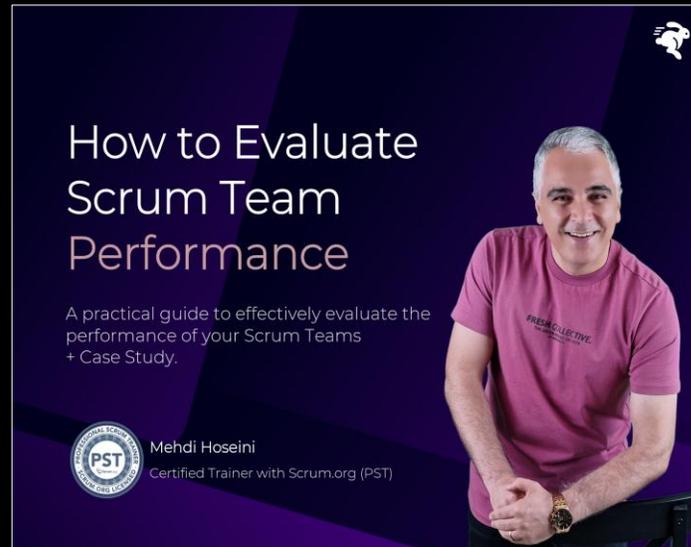

4- Is there any certificate for this course?
